EARLY YEARS Military, Travel, Study & Finding His "Artistic Voice"


Following early years serving in the military where he worked primarily with photography, Myron's travels and artistic studies provided opportunities for experimentation, creation, and re-creation as he discovered his own unique style.

Rising of the Professional Artist

It was here Myron became a professional artist, establishing a daily rhythm and pattern of intense creative development and production, while beginning his family and welcoming his daughter Catherine.





PARIS

Breakout Success, Recognition and Accolades

Myron's Survivors exhibition, originally a three-week show that was extended to 2 ½ months, was proof positive his work evoked strong emotional reactions from the public. It received many positive critical reviews. Gratified and in the glow of success, Myron delved further into refining his art.



Through years of disciplined practice, traveling throughout Europe and Japan studying the works and techniques of the great masters, Barnstone became proficient in using the esoteric science of the Golden Section, a geometric compositional system that brings harmony, drama and life to his pieces.

Establishing studios in Spain, France, England and then America, Barnstone taught for 35 years, producing a legacy of alumni and master arts instructors that carry forward the Barnstone Method today.





ENGLAND

England, US, & Early Teaching Engagements

This period saw Myron synthesize his artistic accomplishments and delve further into explorations, infusing even greater character into his figurative studies and bringing his nature artwork into full flourishing. Myron began teaching at what alumni described as "studios flooded with light and creativity."





AMERICA The Barnstone Method & Barnstone Studios

Seeing a pronounced lack of foundational training and classical technique in modern art education, Myron committed to the radical notion that traditional classical systems must be taught and applied to any work of design. Wanting students to develop their individual artistic styles rather than imitate the appearance of their teacher's work, Myron made the decision to set his own artwork aside and dedicate himself exclusively to educating the next generation of artists. Thus the Barnstone Method was born.

EXPANDING ACCESS Barnstone Philanthropic Support

Art education should be made available to any who committed to the rigor - so Myron believed. Frequently he allowed students to assist with studio prep, maintenance and cleaning in exchange for studying with the classes. Innovative accommodations were the norm, with some students actually living in-studio for extended periods. Formalizing scholarship access to the Barnstone Method now lives on in the Gwendolyn Stine Scholarship Program, affording access to classes, materials and Master Guide expertise two to three times yearly.



Art Education

THE BARNSTONE METHOD

Myron insisted that everyone who truly wished to do so could "learn to draw very well." Barnstone knew that through diligent practice, students could come to understand epic art and its foundational principles, be able to use those principles to discover their own style, and begin to create their own unique artistic expression.

Realizing the classical approach to teaching foundational art skills was being forgotten, Myron created a unique art education experience that captured the essential artistic language of the masters, while maintaining a student's freedom to explore and establish their own style using those foundational techniques. He showed students how to incorporate classical traditions and skills into modern and contemporary design, to engage with present-day needs. Building upon classical, foundational knowledge conveyed in the <u>Barnstone</u> <u>Method</u>, Myron encouraged students to find their own unique style – undergirded by a traceable centuries-long legacy of proven artistic genius to support them. Each facet of Barnstone's unique approach has been captured digitally, including a full suite of Barnstone Method lessons taught by the master himself, complete with exercises and reference materials. Live in-person and live online instruction courses are taught by Senior Instructor & Master Guide Roger Brinker, as well as selected instructors who are certified Barnstone Method Master Guides.

Nurturing and building his student's unique artistic voice - from a strong mastery of the skills and techniques that are Western art's legacy - is Roger Brinker's specialty. In fact, using the idea of an artistic genealogy, Brinker traces his own teachers' artistic roots and charts a lineage that links his students in a direct line to artists such as Edgar Degas, Raphael, and Leonardo da Vinci. A graduate of Temple University's Tyler School of Art, Brinker has been an instrumental part of Barnstone Studios for decades, contributing as education advisor, writing design course workbooks, and developing the curriculum for the new <u>Foundation in Drawing & Design</u> program.







Myron Barnstone met with favorable reviews for his exhibits across Europe: however, when Myron established his educational studios, he made the decision to hide his work for decades, so it would not influence the unique emerging styles of his students. After his passing, these collections of Myron's work have been resurrected, cataloged and studied – Institutions interested in hosting these shows can contact Barnstone Studios directly to negotiate scheduling.


